



DR. JÁNOS BURAI-KOVÁCS is a Hungarian attorney admitted to the Budapest Bar Association and senior partner of the BPSS Attorneys at Law (Budapest, Hungary). Dr. Burai-Kovács is the President of the Court of Arbitration attached to the Hungarian Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

He specializes in litigation and arbitration international and commercial law.

Dr. Burai-Kovács received his law degree, at the ELTE University (Budapest, Hungary), Faculty of Law in 1974. He got his international trade law diploma in 1976 and was admitted to the Hungarian bar in 1976. Before going into private practice, he served for a number of years as head of legal department of Mineralimpex, the Hungarian state trading company for oil and mining products. During that time, he participated in a legal exchange program that afforded him the opportunity to work in legal departments of companies in Austria, Germany and Switzerland. He is in private practice as an attorney at law and arbitrator since 1989. He was the Hungarian partner of the Winter § Partner Attorneys at Law, Zurich between 1995 and 1996.

He has been an active member of the Budapest Bar Association, also as a member of the Board of the Budapest Bar Association.

He is and has been chairman and sole arbitrator in several arbitrations in and outside Hungary, including arbitration proceedings before the ICC or DIS.

Dr. Burai-Kovács is on the roll of arbitrators of the CIETAC (Peking), the Ukrainian, Slovenian, Serbian, South Korean institutional courts of arbitration and is also a member of the Swiss Arbitration Association.

Dr. Burai-Kovács regularly lectures at domestic and international conferences, is visiting lecturer of the ELTE University, Faculty of Law and is the author / co-author of number of articles and publications appearing in both Hungarian and foreign legal books and papers particularly on arbitration matters. He is *inter alia* the co-author of the commentary to the new Hungarian Arbitration Act.
