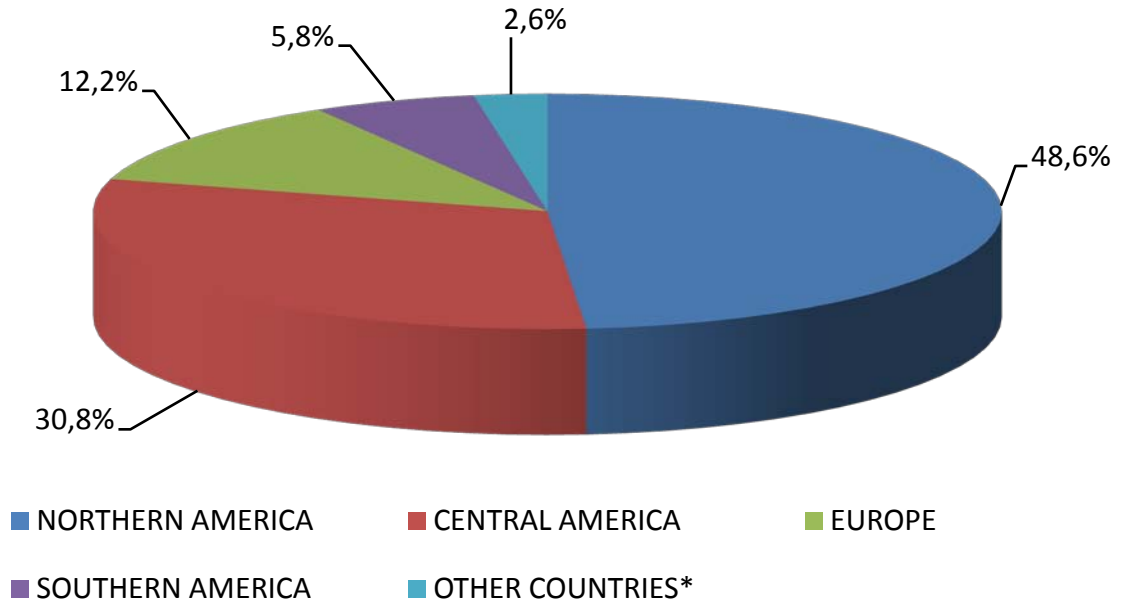

(% DISTRIBUTION). 2012

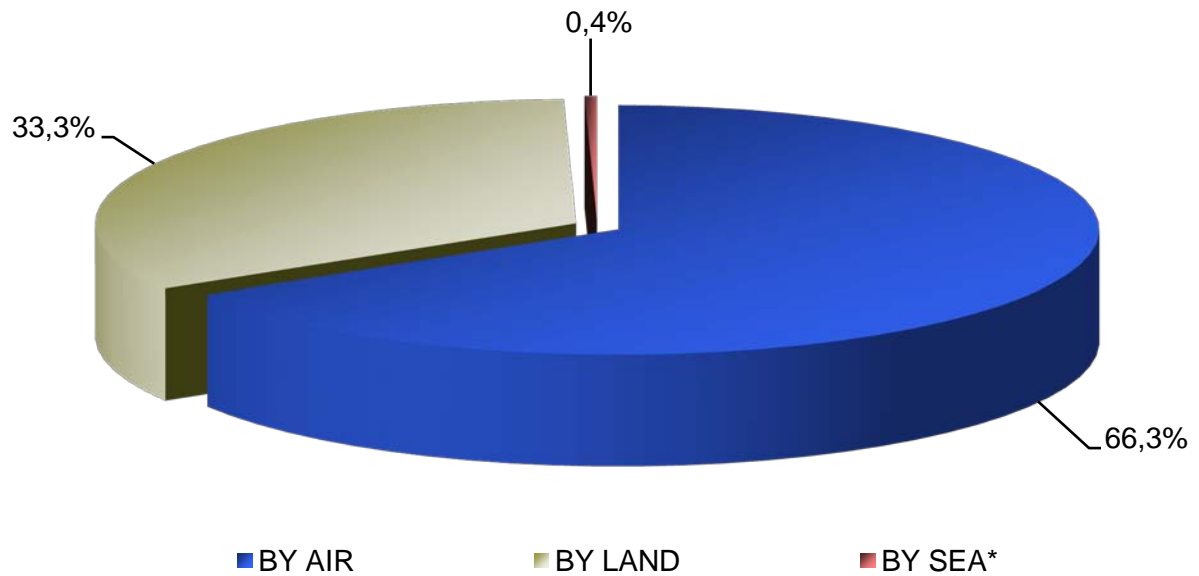

(% DISTRIBUTION). 2012

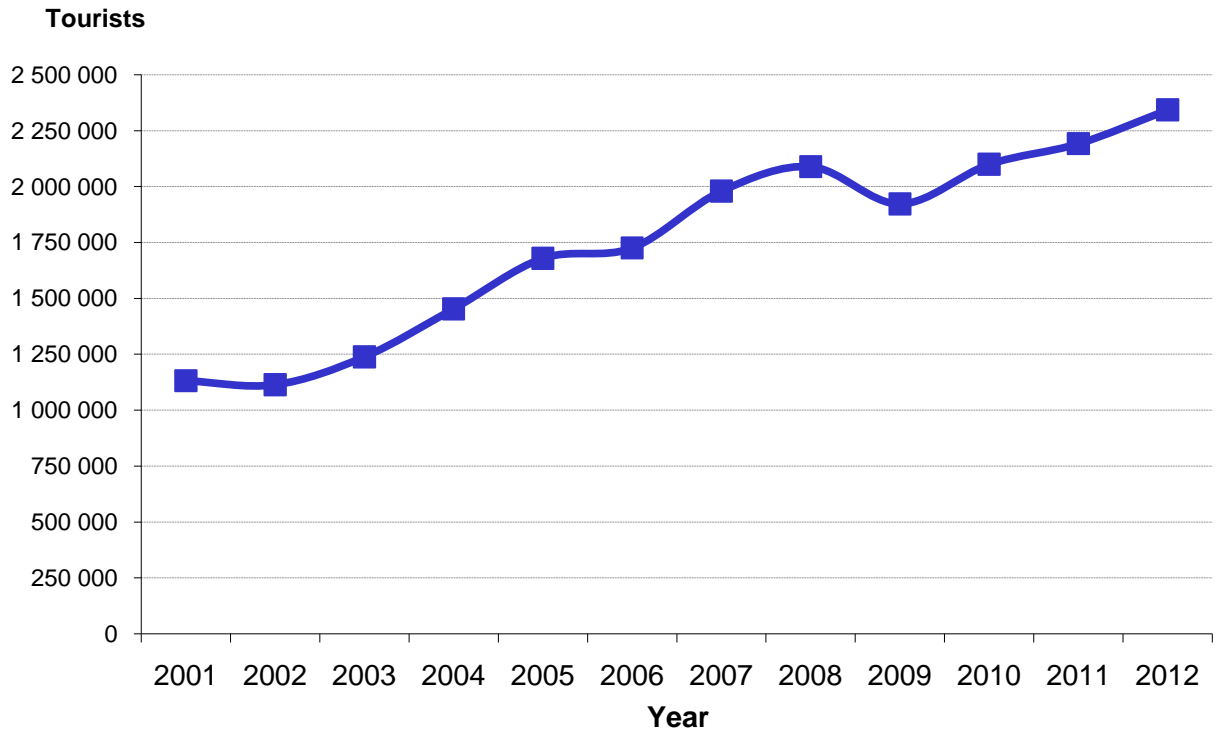

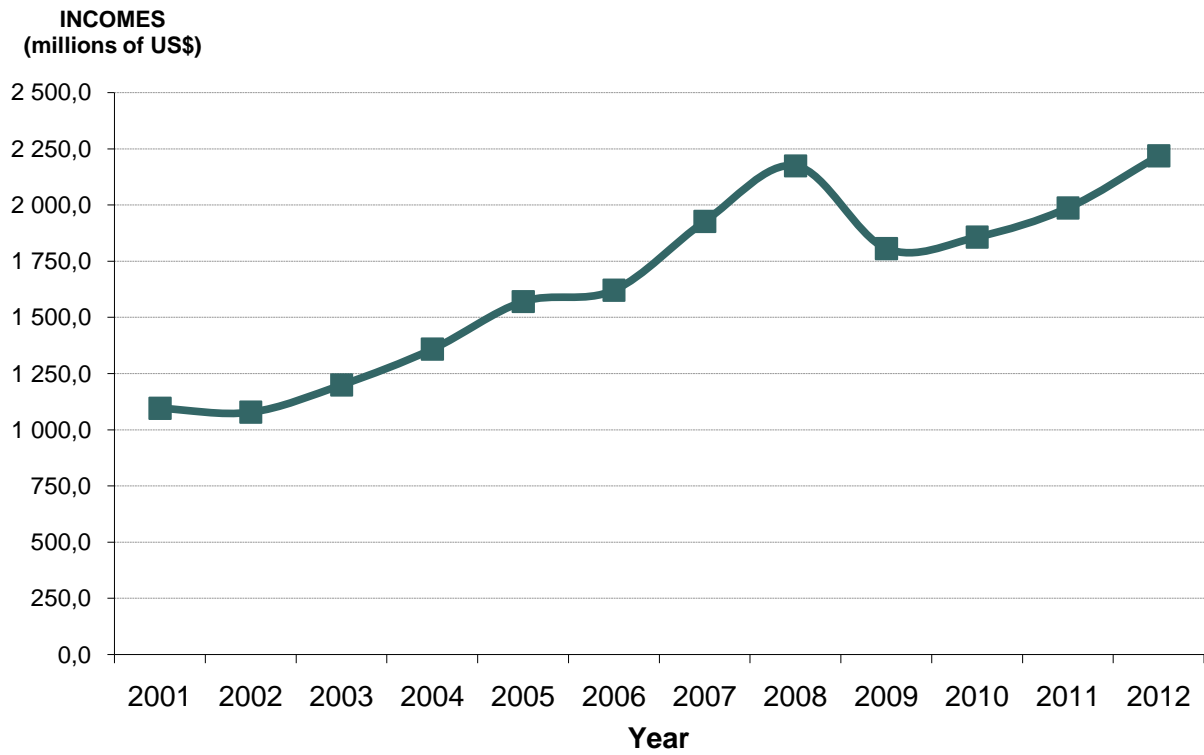
CHART 3
