**Subject:** Note for the Record meeting within Heine Van Niekerk

As you are aware I met with HVN again yesterday 11 June between 12h15 and 1430. I called him last Saturday on 7 June and asked him to come back to London for another meeting. I explained during the call that I had reflected upon what he told me during our meeting and needed to give him feedback in person.

HVN came to my office on 7 Old Park Lane. He immediately gave me a USB stick and told me it contained the reports he had promised me at our last meeting. I have forwarded these reports to you namely;

1. Profile on Alpha Conde
2. Profile on General Konate
3. Profile on Guinea
4. Engagement letter ( Foresight Advisors ) with General Konate
5. Engagement letter ( Foresight Advisors ) with Kamarra

General Konate is currently based in Ethiopia and heads up the African Unions Military initiative see :

We had some coffee, left our mobile phones behind and proceeded to have lunch at a venue I had booked beforehand at Cut 45 Park Lane.

HVN started off by asking me about our relationship with [REDACTED]. He told me that [REDACTED] no longer had the confidence of his employers and had been spreading rumours about Waymark that have no foundation in fact. He also mentioned that [REDACTED] is not employed as a special advisor to the head of the African Union which as you are aware is what he has been telling us for some time. I respond by telling HVN that we have not been engaged with [REDACTED] for a longtime and that we have limited confidence in the information he has provided us with in the past.

HVN then spoke at great length about the logistics surrounding the meeting that took place in SA between himself, Alpha Conde ( AC ) and his Son Mohammed ( MAC ), Moe Shaik ( the head of SASS at that time ) and President Zuma when the South Africans did their deal with AC as explained in the [REDACTED] ). HVN again confirmed that Zuma offered financial, intelligence and election IT support ( Waymark ) with Waymark "fixing" the election and in return AC would as President accommodate financial arrangements with South African interests supported/proposed by Zuma. He mentioned to me that this deal was supposed to be "his" but Walter Hennig, Wilcox and Tokyo Sexwale had outmanoeuvred him and when he subsequently complained about it to Moe Shaik he was told he had had his chance but not moved quickly enough. I asked him if Sammy Membiane was at the actual meeting. He told me he was not and that Sammy had tried to push his way into the meeting but was not included. The Membiane tapes reconcile with this version of events. He told me that AC and MAC had first stayed at the Saxon hotel with HVN picking up the tab but after running up large expenses HVN relocated them to his house. He told me they spent over 15 hrs in the hotel Spa in an attempt to experience all of the treatments on the spa menu. At HVN's house AC became unruly after drinking too much wine and tried to grope and fondle HVN's wife who is an American lawyer and works for Renaissance Capital in Johannesburg. He told me that he gave a pair of very large socks to MAC ( who according to HVN has very large feet ) because he didn't have any and was walking around the house bare footed.

I told HVN that I want to stay on good terms with him but I am dealing with a matter beyond my control [REDACTED] explained that the scenario he is planning for and explained to me at our previous meeting is not a possibility because the [REDACTED] when it becomes public over the next 4 to 6 weeks will put not only Waymark but also him personally at the centre of an important part of the [REDACTED] I asked him for his thoughts. He appeared to be quite shaken by this information but responded very quickly in a precise manner.

He said I should come down to SA and meet with him, the CEO of Waymark, and Moe Shaik. They will explain exactly what happened and how it happened ( the meetings with AC and how Waymark executed its affairs/mandate ). I told him that I felt it to be a good solution but I need to have our lawyers present [REDACTED] who will handle everything in an open and correct way. He said that was a good idea. I told him we will at the same time explore a way for us to work together so that he has an incentive to benefit from establishing the truth of what happened in this regard and that this can only be done in an open and legally correct way and handled by our lawyers. He was very happy about that too.

He told me that he didn't want his daughter to grow up reading about him as the man who fixed the Guinean elections. He also back tracked a little bit mumbling about Waymark's fix being done legally but they will explain it all. He then asked me again for the evidence that we have of the corrupt practices of MAC and Sampil Boubucar. I told him we have extensive data and proof of their criminality and once we have his and his colleagues cooperation and statements documented we will consider sharing it with him.

We have tentatively scheduled for the SA meeting to take place the week of 23 June.

Please let me know your availability as soon as possible. I suggest arrival in JHB morning 23 June. Return that evening or on 24.
