DR LUKAS DANIEL 'NIEL' BARNARD



Dr Barnard followed an impressive academic career at the University of the Free State during which he held the position of Professor and Head of Department of Political Science, After completing his PhO he furthered his post-doctoral studies in Nuclear Strategy at the Centre for Strategic and International Studies at Georgetown University in the United States

In 1980, at age 31, Dr Barnard was appointed as Director General and Head of the National Intelligence Service of South Africa where he rapidly made his mark revolutionising the country's civilian intelligence service to an unprecedented level of maturity and placing it on a par with the most celebrated intelligence services in the world at the time.

The South African political transformation process was actively driven by Dr Barnard who was possionate about achieving a peaceful transition. Acting as always behind the scenes, Dr Bernard was involved in shepherding this process, inter all a conducting a number of secret negotiations with the then imprisoned Nelson Mandela as well as Thatso Mbeki, Jacob Zuma and other senior ANC figures in exite at that time,

In addition, he conducted virtually countless secret negotiations with African's - Professor and Head of Departm Heads of State as well as a plethora of military and civilian intelligence leaders in Africa and elsewhere.

In 1992 Or Barnard took up the reins of the body tasked with formulating a constitution for the future democratic South Africa, notably the Department of Constitutional Development where he retained and expanded his position as key role-player in the peaceful transition leading to the landmark 1994 elections,

Subsequently, he served as frequent advisor to successive Presidents while his skills as mediator also extended to regional conflicts as well as those further afield, inter alia in his capacity as ... facilitator in the Israeli-Palestinian conflict in the Middle East during the period 2004-2007.

At the conflicion of his career in national intelligence and subsequent active government duty, fir Barnard continued to pursue his intense interest in global and African affairs through the provision of consulting services to both portial structures and the private sector.
