TO AUTHORIZE A REQUEST FOR ARBITRATION AND ITS SUBMISSION TO THE INTERNATIONAL CENTER FOR SETTLEMENT OF INVESTMENT DISPUTES

WHEREAS SIA North Star (the "Company") has been involved in a dispute with the Government of the Kingdom of Norway ("Norway") regarding the Company's investments pertaining to snow crab harvesting activities ("Dispute");

WHEREAS the Dispute notably arises under the Agreement between the Government of the Kingdom of Norway and the Government of the Republic of Latvia on the Mutual Promotion and Protection of Investments ("BIT");

WHEREAS the Company, through its legal counsel, has notified Norway of the existence of the Dispute through a trigger letter dated 8 March 2019;

WHEREAS the Dispute remains unresolved;

WHEREAS the Company wishes to submit the Dispute to arbitration under the jurisdiction of the International Center for Settlement of Investment Disputes ("ICSID");

BE IT RESOLVED:

1. To appoint the following legal counsel ("Counsel") to represent and assist the Company as its agents, counsel and advocates in the matter of its Dispute against Norway:
