Referring to the phone call today. We have a small comment on the overview report, Section 2.2 “Applied geometries”. Here we would like to see the text amended as follows:

“The geometries (areas of jurisdiction) covered in this report are: The Norwegian Exclusive Economic Zone, the Fisheries Protection Zone around Svalbard and the Loop Hole (*Translators note: the area is also known as Smutthullet. Smutthullet = Loop hole in Norwegian*) (the area of the Barents Sea beyond 200 nautical miles) as delimited into Norwegian Continental Shelf and Russian Continental Shelf. Around 90% of the continental shelf in the Loop Hole is under Russian jurisdiction. ”
