Regulations on amending the Regulations on Registration and Reporting for Fishing in waters outside any State's Fisheries Jurisdiction.

On 18 April 2013, Regulations No 173 of 4 March 1998 on the regulations of fishing in waters outside any State's fishing jurisdiction Sections 2 and 5 has laid down the following regulations:

Section 1 (as amended) shall be replaced by the following:

§ 1 Scope

This Regulations applies to Norwegian nationals and persons resident in Norway who fish with Norwegian vessels in waters outside any State's jurisdiction that is not regulated by regional or subregional fisheries management organisations or events with separate reporting provisions. The Regulations also applies to the NEAFC Regulatory Area.

The Regulations enters into force immediately.

The Regulations are as follows:

Regulations on registration and reporting for fishing in waters outside the jurisdiction of any State

On 30 June 1999, the Directorate of Fisheries, pursuant to Sections 2 and 5 of the Regulations of 4 March 1998 on the Regulations related to fishing in waters outside any State's jurisdiction on fisheries, has laid down the following regulations:

§ 1 Scope

This Regulations applies to Norwegian nationals and persons resident in Norway who fish with Norwegian vessels in waters outside any State's jurisdiction that is not regulated by regional or subregional fisheries management organisations or events with separate reporting provisions. The Regulations also applies to the NEAFC regulatory area.

§ 2 Registration

Vessels intended to fish in waters as mentioned in Section 1 must be registered in advance through notification to the Directorate of Fisheries:

- (a) before 1 January each year, if possible; or
- B) in good time before departure from the port of residence; or
- C) within 3 days from the change date if there are changes to the information provided in the Registration Notice.

The message shall be sent by fax or e-mail and shall contain the following information:

The year for which the Registration Message applies

Name of ship

Ship's radio call signal

Registration number of the ship in the registration register or IMO number if the ship does not have a registration number

Name and address of vessel owner

Sea area/r to be fished in

Fish species that are the main target for fishing

Type of ship

Tonnage of vessel

Length of vessel

Vessel power

Section 3 Reporting

Vessels fishing in waters as referred to in Section 1 shall send the notifications provided for in this provision. The messages must be sent electronically to the Directorate of Fisheries.

The person responsible on board the ship shall ensure the proper functioning of the reporting system.

Messages sent in accordance with this regulations are considered not received by the Fisheries Directorate if the sender does not receive a return message or the return message shows the message status NAK.

1. Notification about start of fishing activities.

Notification of start of fishing activities must be sent no earlier than 12 hours and no later than 2 hours before entrance to the area.

2. Catch notofication.

Weekly catch notification shall first be sent at the latest at the end of the seventh day after entry into the area, or if caught beyond 7 days the vessel shall submit a catch report no later than Monday at 12:00 for catches taken in the area during the last week until midnight Sunday.

3. Transshipment notification.

Transshipment to vessels from EU, Russia, Faroe Islands, Greenland, Iceland and Norway and vessels from NEAFC countries is permitted.

Vessels intended to deliver the catch shall, not later than 24 hours before the commencement of reloading, send notification of reloading. Vessels that have received catch from other vessels shall, no later than one hour after the individual reloading has been completed, send notification of reloading.

Any person who intently or negligently violates provisions of this Regulations is punished in accordance with Sections 62 and 64 of the Act relating to the Management of Wilder Common Marine Resources (Sea Resources Act) of 6 June 2008 No 37. Similarly, complicity and trials shall be punished

§ 5 Implementation

This Regulations enters into force on 1 July 1999.
